## **ANNEX 1: Project Context**

The project aims to reduce greenhouse gas emissions in the Russian Federation by transforming the market for industrial energy efficiency in GHG-intensive industries. The project has been designed taking stock of the actual situation with respect to industrial energy efficiency in Russia and trying to leverage the significant opportunity given by the recent adoption of the Russian Energy Efficiency Law.

The project will achieve this market transformation through activities that will:

- 1. Have a direct and sustainable positive effect on the management and rational use of energy in Russian industry;
- 2. Structurally improve industrial energy efficiency in heavy and light industries through increased energy efficiency investments,
- 3. Improve the technical capacity of enterprises personnel and industrial energy efficiency services providers
- 4. Improve the capacity of Russian Federation and states governments to develop and implement effective policies and programs aimed to support industrial energy efficiency.

The project has been jointly developed by UNIDO and the European Bank for Reconstruction and Development (EBRD) and it will be jointly implemented, building also on an energy efficiency credit line facility (RUSEFF) recently established by EBRD.

UNIDO is responsible for the delivery of most training activities targeted to national IEE consultants and service providers (hereinafter called Experts), enterprises/SMEs personnel and government officials. With respect to the first two target groups (Experts and enterprise personnel), UNIDO will deliver tailored training programs to introduce and strengthen capacity for the development and implementation of energy management systems and energy systems (steam, compressed-air, pumps, etc.) optimization measures and projects in large energy-intensive industries as well as in SMEs.

The project is funded by the Global Environmental Facility (GEF) and it runs from August 2010 to December 2017.
